Read the passage carefully and answer the questions that follow: On 28 March, at around 12:50 p.m. local time, a powerful 7.7 magnitude earthquake struck central Myanmar, with its epicentre near Mandalay and Sagaing cities at a shallow depth of 10km. The tremors were felt across the country and beyond. Another 6.4 magnitude earthquake further south followed within minutes. Preliminary reports indicate that upwards of 1,000 people have been killed and over 2,200 others injured, while approximately 200 others are missing in central and north-western Myanmar. The majority of the deaths were reported in the Mandalay area. The State Administration Council (SAC) has declared

a state of emergency for Bago Region, Mandalay Region, Nay Pyi Taw Union Territory, Sagaing Region and parts of Shan State and called for international assistance.

The earthquake caused widespread destruction of homes and severe damage to critical infrastructure. Initial reports indicate that Mandalay International Airport (with commercial flights cancelled until further notice), major bridges, roads, universities, hotels, historical and religious sites and public service buildings in urban and rural areas have been heavily damaged or destroyed. Thousands of people are spending the nights on the streets or open spaces due to the damage and destruction to home or fearing further quakes. Supply infrastructure and communication towers were severely impacted, electricity and water services were disrupted, including in Yangon Region. Landline, mobile and internet networks remain unstable. Damage to the Yangon-Nay Pyi Taw-Mandalay expressway led to service disruptions, with cracks and surface distortions, forcing highway buses to halt operations. As the full scale of the disaster unfolds, urgent humanitarian assistance is needed

The ongoing conflict between Israel and Hamas has once again escalated, with both sides enduring significant losses. This latest round of violence began in early 2025 after a series of skirmishes and attacks from both parties. Hamas, the militant group that controls the Gaza Strip, launched rocket attacks targeting several Israeli cities, including Tel Aviv and Jerusalem. In response, Israel conducted airstrikes on Gaza, targeting Hamas infrastructure and military sites. The fighting has resulted in hundreds of casualties, most of them from Gaza, where civilian areas have been heavily impacted.

The root of the conflict lies in long standing political and territorial disputes. The Gaza strip, a small and densely populated area, has been under Hamas' control since 2007. Israel, which views Hamas as a terrorist organization, has imposed a blockade on the region, citing security concerns and the threat of weapons being smuggled into Gaza. Over the years, intermittent clashes have led to numerous casualties and widespread destruction.

International reactions have been mixed. Some countries have expressed solidarity with Israel's right to defend itself, while others

have called for a ceasefire and urged both sides to engage in peace talks. The United Nations has called for an urgent resolution to the violence, fearing that the conflict could spread further, destabilizing the entire region.

The conflict continues to draw attention from the global community, with many hoping for a path to peace that addresses the underlying issues of territorial disputes, security concerns, and humanitarian rights.

Siliguri, 27th April: The Department of English, in collaboration with the IOAC of Surva Sen Mahavidyalaya, organized a two-day interdepartmental workshop titled "Bridging Words: A Translation Workshop on Regional Languages" on 24 and 25 April, 2025. Poet and translator Shyamali Sengupta (Odiya and Bangla) and eminent playwright, poet and translator Krishna Pradhan (Nepali, Bangla and English) served as the resource persons of the workshop.

The initiative aimed to enhance students' translation skills, deepen their understanding of translation theories and practices, and highlight translation as a viable professional avenue. "Developing proficiency in translation tasks with accuracy and fluency can open doors to professional opportunities," noted Dr. P.K. Mishra, Principal of the college, in his inaugural address.

Dr. Arnab Baul, Head of the English Department, stressed the intricate relationship between translation and identity, pointing out that a translator navigates not only the author's and reader's identities, but also the identity of their own.

Workshop Coordinator Prof. Sutapa Saha underlined the role of translation in fostering global communication and promoting intercultural understandings. IQAC coordinator Dr. Babli Mondal fondly recalled how translated European comics had shaped young minds, demonstrating the transformative power of translation at an early age.

Sharing their personal experiences, both Sengupta and Pradhan emphasized the delicate balance between remaining faithful to the source text and adapting content to suit cultural and linguistic nuances. They highlighted the importance of respecting regional idioms and expressions while preserving the author's original intent.

The second day of the workshop featured hands-on training sessions where participants practised translating texts, received feedbacks, and engaged in peer critiques, fostering a collaborative learning atmosphere.
