

### Merit Scholarship Scheme

INTRODUCTION	: The Scheme is introduced in the year <b>1997</b> .
APPLICABILITY	: The Scheme is applicable to any individual. He/She should have passed the qualifying examination in the <b>current</b> year 20.....(in first attempt) only. Those having passed earlier are not eligible.
ELIGIBILITY CATEGORIES	: Scholarship can be availed for students enrolled for full-time courses only. : Category <b>A</b> - for doing 9th - 10th class course. : Category <b>B</b> - for doing 11th - 12th class course. : Category <b>C</b> - for doing Graduation course. : Category <b>D</b> - for doing Post-graduate course. : Category <b>P</b> - for doing Professional course.
NUMBER OF SCHOLARSHIPS	: Shall be granted on the basis of merit of the marks and reservation factor. : Category <b>A</b> - 15, Category <b>B</b> - 15, Category <b>C</b> - 10, Category <b>D</b> - 10, Category <b>P</b> - 10. : If the number of applications are large, the management may increase the limit according to the requirements.
SCHOLARSHIP AMOUNT	: Category <b>A</b> - Rs. 400/- P.M. for two years. : Category <b>B</b> - Rs. 500/- P.M. for two years. : Category <b>C</b> - Rs. 600/- P.M. for two or three years as applicable. : Category <b>D</b> - Rs. 700/- P.M. for two or three years as applicable. : Category <b>P</b> - Rs. 1000/- P.M. for two or three years as applicable.
UTILISATION OF SCHOLARSHIP AMOUNT	: It should be used by the Students on himself and on his studies only
MINIMUM QUALIFICATION EXAMINATION	: Category <b>A</b> - 8th Class or equivalent. : Category <b>B</b> - 10th Class or equivalent. : Category <b>C</b> - 12th Class or equivalent. : Category <b>D</b> - Graduate Degree. : Category <b>P</b> - 12th Class / Graduate Degree.
MINIMUM QUALIFYING PERCENTAGE	: Category <b>A</b> - 75% aggregate in class 8th : Category <b>B</b> - 75% aggregate in class 10th : Category <b>C</b> - 75% aggregate (Science & Commerce), 65% aggregate (Humanities/Arts) : Category <b>D</b> - 60% aggregate (Science & Commerce), 50% aggregate (Humanities/Arts) : Category <b>P</b> - 60% aggregate (Science & Commerce), 50% aggregate (Humanities/Arts)
UNIQUE SCHOLARSHIP RESERVATION	: Applicant should not be getting any other kind of scholarship from elsewhere. : <b>20%</b> Scholarships in each category are <b>reserved</b> for : : I. Special Category - handicapped : II. Excellence extra-curricular activities like sports, NCC 'B' certificate holder debating, dramatics & social services. : III. Economically weaker section - of those students, whose parents Annual Income is not more than Rs. 1,20,000/- (Rupees One lac twenty thousand only) : Minimum qualifying percentage need not apply to them.
SELECTION COMMITTEE	: The merit list is discussed and analyzed for final selection by a high level Selection panel, constituted by the Trust Management. The decision of this committee shall be final and binding for all the purposes.
CONTINUITY	: If granted Scholarship, the holder will have to provide continuity certificate issued by the head of the Institution every quarter. The holder has to submit the statement of A/c with proper authentication about the Utilisation of Scholarship amount.
BASIS OF SCHEME	: This has been compiled from various records available on this subject and subsequent development as decided in various committee meetings.
LAST DATE FOR MAKING APPLICATION	: <b>The application must reach our office on or before 31st July, 20.....</b>
